Horse Management Clinic: Jan 23rd 9am-4pm (Cost: \$15/ Member, 1 Parent or HMX incl free with paid youth!)

Small groups of UR-C1 Members, HMX's & Parents rotate through educational stations led by C1-UL members with breaks scheduled for large group games/information sessions.

This is a fun and inexpensive opportunity to learn about Horse care, Pony Club, see old friends and make new friends around the region!

Lunch will not be included in your clinic fee price. Members/Parents/chaperones/fans will need to buy their own lunch. FVPC will be selling lunches for \$7/plate pre ordered/paid (\$8/plate paid day of -Limited extra meals available).

Model Horse Show: Jan 24th 11 am ~ 12:30pm (Fee: \$1/horse/class - you can enter multiple horses per class)

Members may choose to bring more model horses to enter in our Low Key model horse show. Enter on day of show no pre-registration required other than indicating interest. More information to come.

EBTH Rally: Jan 24th ~9am - 3pm (Cost \$60/team 3-4 "riders" + SM, or \$15/ indiv scrambling on a team)

This is the perfect way to practice rally prep and learn rally procedures without needing to care for a "real" horse. Members Compete in Horse Management, Dressage and Show Jumping Rally with their "model horse". Before the rally teams work together to build "shoe box" stalls and make "rally kits" from cut out pictures or Model sized versions of equipment.

Additional info for EBTH:

- Assemble teams of 3-5 competitors - any age and mixed ratings are OK!! Unrated members can be on the same teams as any D or Cs! 3-4 riders and one Stable Manager per team allowed. \$60 per team or \$15 per individual for scramble members.
- Each competitor needs to find their favorite model horse - doesn't have to be a name brand.... Your chosen horse will need a feed chart and stall chart - make sure they are specific for your model (ie NOT your real horse's stall chart)!
- Each competitor needs to convert a boot box/cardboard box into a rally stall!! Get creative - pull out the paperclips, tape, push pins and other random office supplies to set up your stall. No extra points for fancy wooden custom stalls - although they are fun to see!!
- Stable Managers can help assemble the tack and feed stalls too!
- Start gathering your rally kit items - either actual model horse items or photos of the actual items are great! No life-sized items are needed!
- Each team will need to bring a card table to set their "stalls" on.
- Lunch will not be included in your rally fee price. Parents/chaperones/fans will also need to buy their own lunch as well for \$7/plate pre ordered/paid (\$8/plate paid day of)
- Remember your armband/PC Pin and barn safe footwear! (Snowboots are approved). No riding attire is necessary - only warm winter clothing. (Please be clean and neat as possible)
- Horse Management judging will be done with the same forms we use for actual rallies.
- The dressage test will be sent when the registration form is distributed - remember to practice it ahead of time! Bring a test reader if you need one - no penalty points.
